

Aboriginal Affairs Planning Authority Act, 1972
(Section 31)

PERMIT TO ENTER A RESERVE

In pursuance of the provisions of section 31 of the Aboriginal Affairs Planning Authority Act, 1972, and the regulations made under that Act, I hereby grant permission to enter and remain on Aboriginal Reserve No(s) 17614, 25050, 25051, 99999 in the State of Western Australia, subject to the conditions that the person(s) named herein shall at all times -

Conditions

- 1) Enter and remain on the reserve for the purposes of "Transit and Refueling" only. The permit is only valid for the persons, purpose and dates specified herein.
- 2) Carry the permit in the vehicle specified herein while on reserve land.
- 3) Observe all laws having application in Western Australia including Aboriginal Community by-laws.
- 4) Refrain from consuming alcohol within reserve lands unless the appropriate approvals have been obtained.
- 5) Refrain from hunting or fishing within reserve lands unless prior approvals have been obtained.
- 6) Refrain from littering within reserve lands and observe fire restrictions and regulations.
- 7) Refrain from mining and/or prospecting (including fossicking) activity within reserve lands. A specific permit is required for this purpose.
- 8) Refrain from using firearms within reserve lands.
- 9) Remain on established roads and use approved camping areas/accommodation unless specific permission to do otherwise has been obtained.

This Permit is valid from the 30th of September, 2017 and expires on the 5th of October, 2017 unless sooner revoked by the Minister
